### **Supplies**

- Peach 100% cotton fabric
- Peach pencil or air soluble pen for marking
- Water proof pencils in blue, orange, and red
- Thin line permanent markers in red, blue, black, and brown
- White acrylic paint and a thin brush
- Powdered blush
- Polyester stuffing
- One pair of 20 mm doll joints
- One pair of 30 mm doll joints
- One size 9 blond acrylic doll wig
- Gold thread for Irene's ring
- Red acrylic paint for Irene's ring
- 6" wide eyelet finished on one side for the drawers and slip
- ½" elastic
- Snaps or hook and loop tape for the dress
- White cotton batiste for the dress

- 1/4" white lace edging for the dress
- Machine embroidery ribbon beading with a ¼" seam allowance on each side for the dress
- 4 mm blue silk ribbon for the dress
- Cotton hand embroidery thread in red, green, and blue for the dress
- Purchased 2" by 7/8" doll shoes
- Purchased doll tights for 14" to 15" doll
- Blue acrylic paint for necklace
- About ninety 3 mm pearls for necklace
- Jewelry clasp for necklace

# **Equipment**

- Basic sewing tools (see **Tools**, **Tips**, and **Techniques**)
- Embroidery hoop and needles
- Disposable plastic bowl and craft stick for dyeing beads
- Stringing needle for stringing beads

#### **Skills**

- Intermediate skills in sewing and doll making
- Color face with pen and pencil
- Attach head to body with ladder stitch
- Machine sewing fingers
- Shadow embroidery
- Applying lace and embroidery beading

#### **Sizes**

- Princess Irene is about fifteen inches tall
- Her clothes can be worn by Madam Alexander's® 14" dolls
- Princess Irene can wear clothes intended for Madam Alexander's 14" doll
